### In-Person Prioritization Data

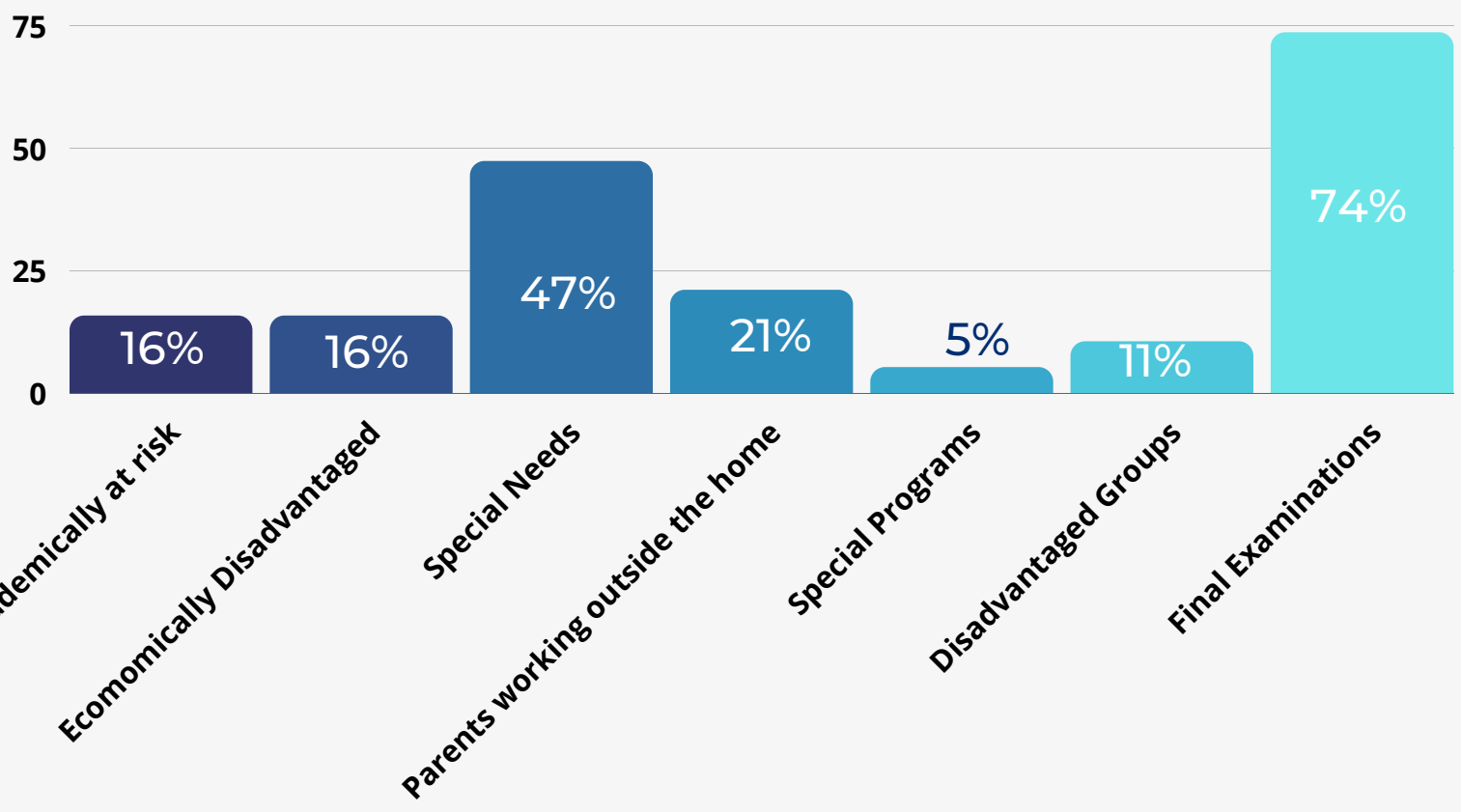


About **1 in 4**

### Special Needs

Upper middle-income and high-income countries are more likely to be prioritizing in-person learning for student with special needs.

### Final Examinations

Low-income countries are 2.6X more likely to prioritize students sitting for a final examination for in-person learning, compared to high-income countries.

Low-income and lower middle-income countries are 3.5x more likely to prioritize schools in rural areas for in-person learning, compared to high-income countries.



**97%**

Globally, 97% of countries are prioritizing in-person learning based upon low COVID-19 community transmission.
